

FY 2007 Grants to Indian Tribal Governments Program Grantees

Current grantees who received an FY 2007 Tribal Governments Program award can apply for continuation funding under Purpose Area #6 of the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation. However, a FY 2007 OVW award recipient that received an FY 2009 Tribal Governments Program funding may only request funding to continue or enhance the activities that are currently supported with its FY 2007 grant award. OVW **will not** offer funding to any current grantee to sustain, maintain, or otherwise support activities that were funded by OVW in Fiscal Year 2009.
