



## Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS) Performance Measures

To assist in fulfilling the Department of Justice's (DOJ) responsibilities under the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA), P.L. 103-62, applicants who receive funding under this solicitation must provide data that measure the results of their work.

As referred to in the solicitation, Part G, IV, CTAS has one overarching objective that applies to all ten purpose areas and separate objectives for each of the purpose areas. While the solicitation listed a sample of applicable performance measures and data, this document contains a comprehensive list of all required performance measures and data. Grantees will be required to provide data for the overarching measure and the measures for the purpose areas under which they were funded.

Grantees are required to provide the data requested in the "Data Grantee Provides" column for each applicable objective so that DOJ can calculate values for the "Performance Measures" column. After awards are made, DOJ staff will provide additional information about how data should be collected and reported.
